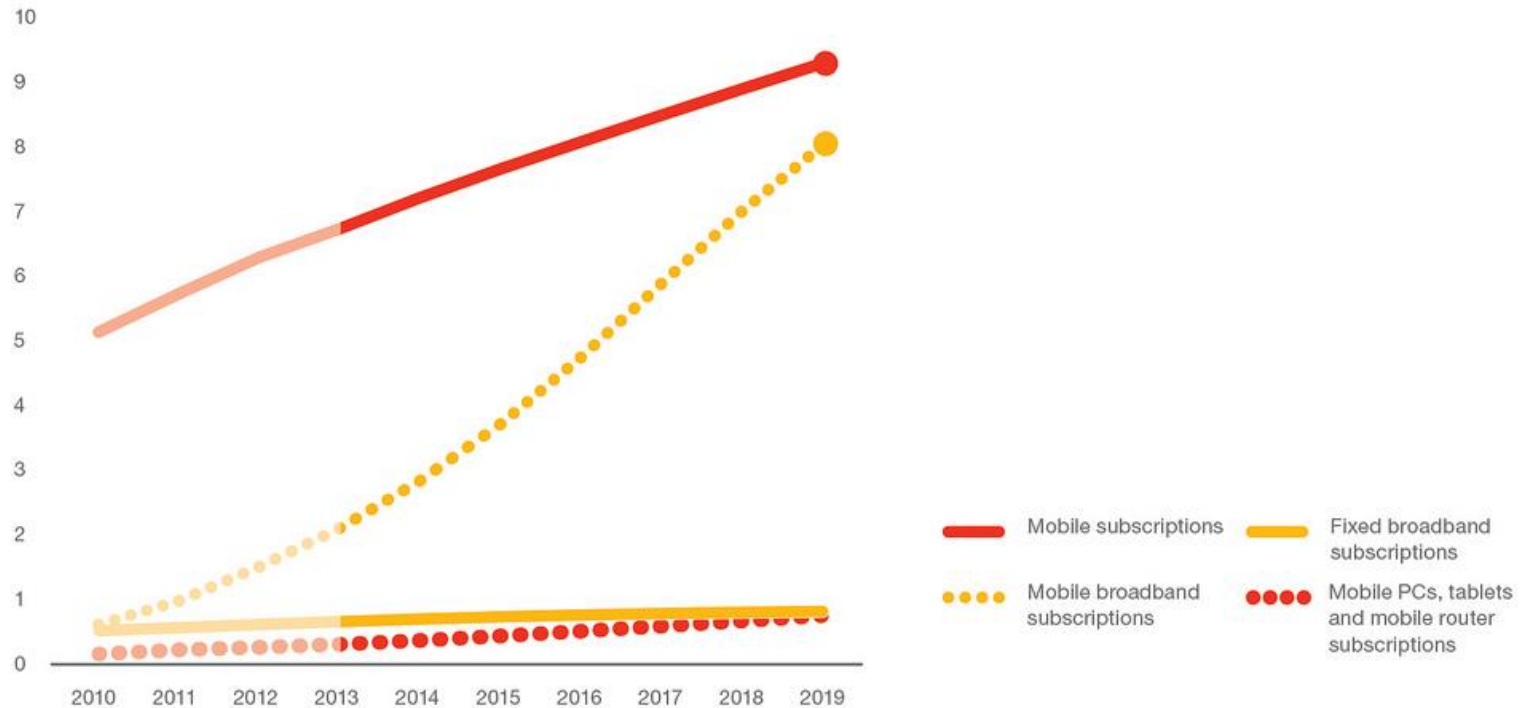

Subscriptions/lines (billion)

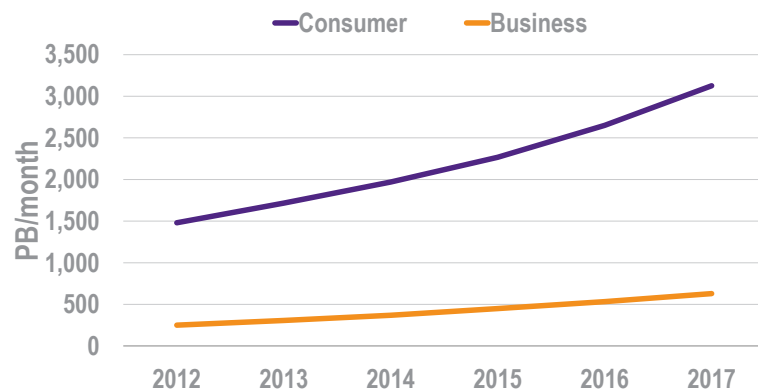

The centre of gravity for application development is shifting to mobile

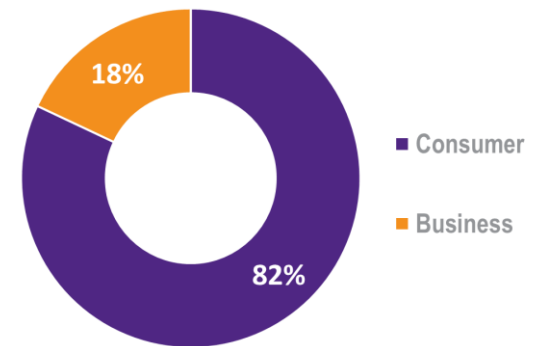
Most traffic is consumer traffic

Share of mobile data traffic by category

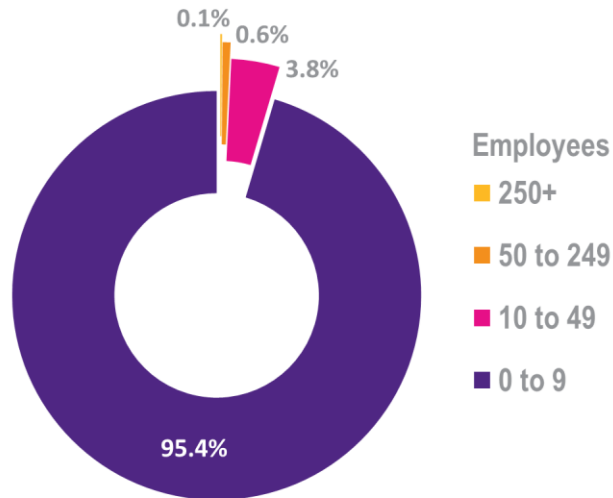

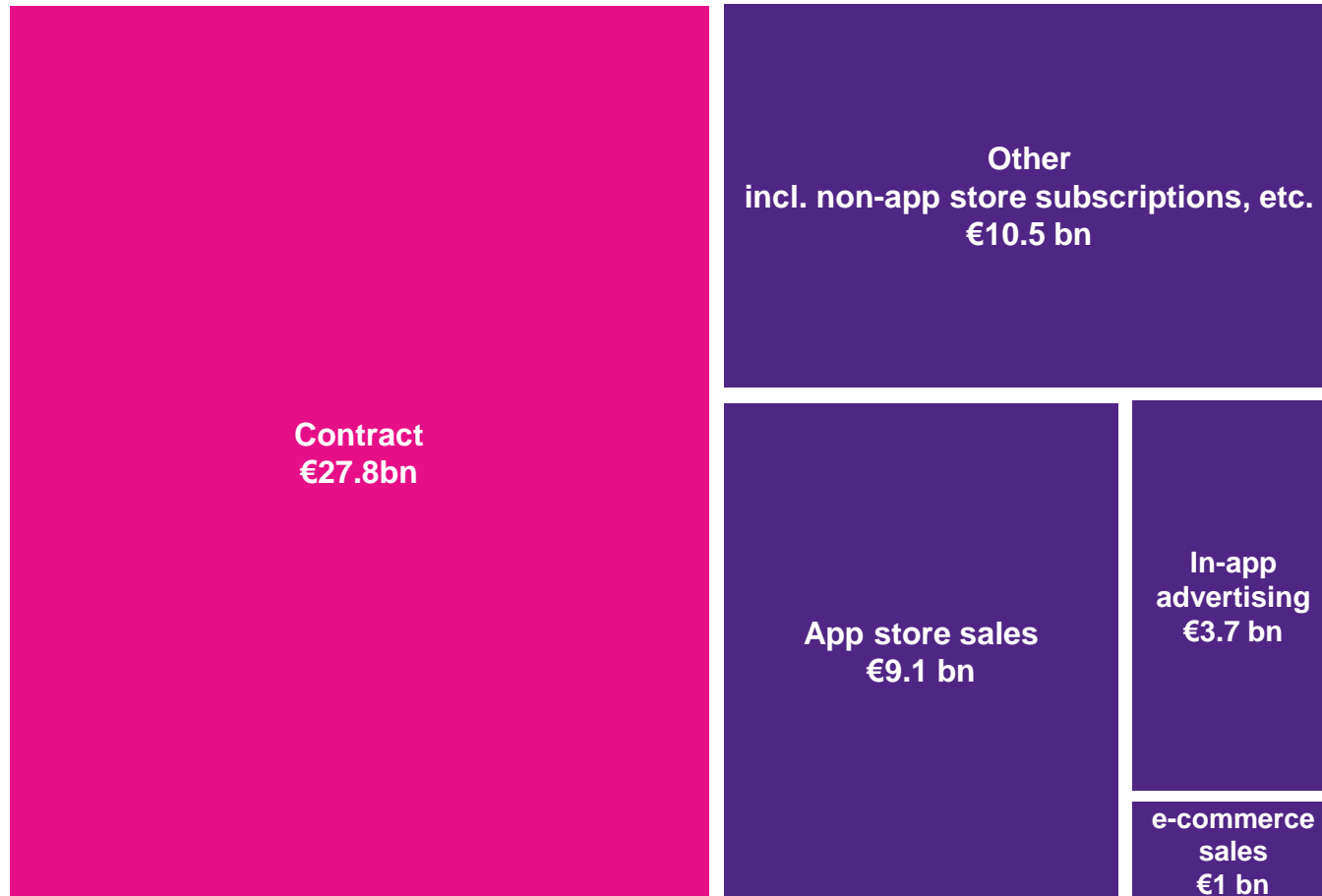

- By 2015 only 60% of enterprise IT expenditure managed centrally (Gartner)

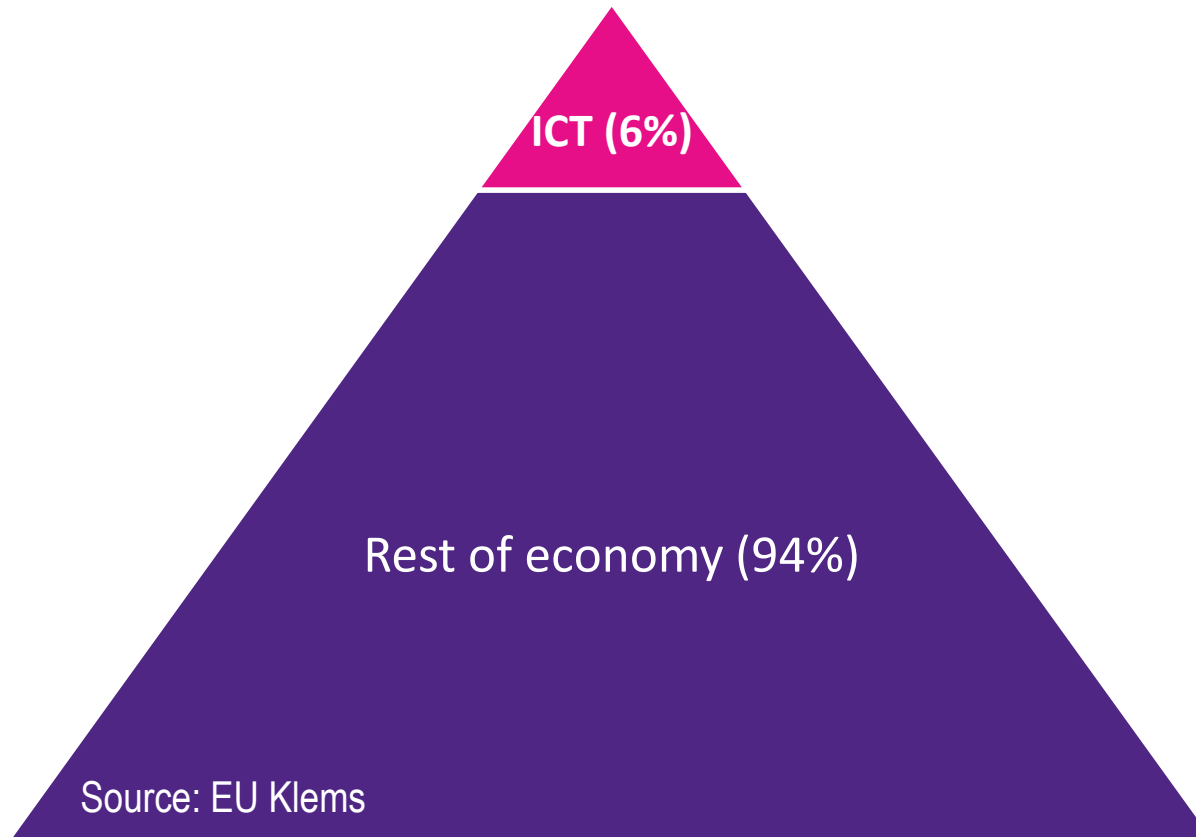
Driving adoption & development of productivity apps (2nd fastest growth category after messaging)

However enterprise apps market is large

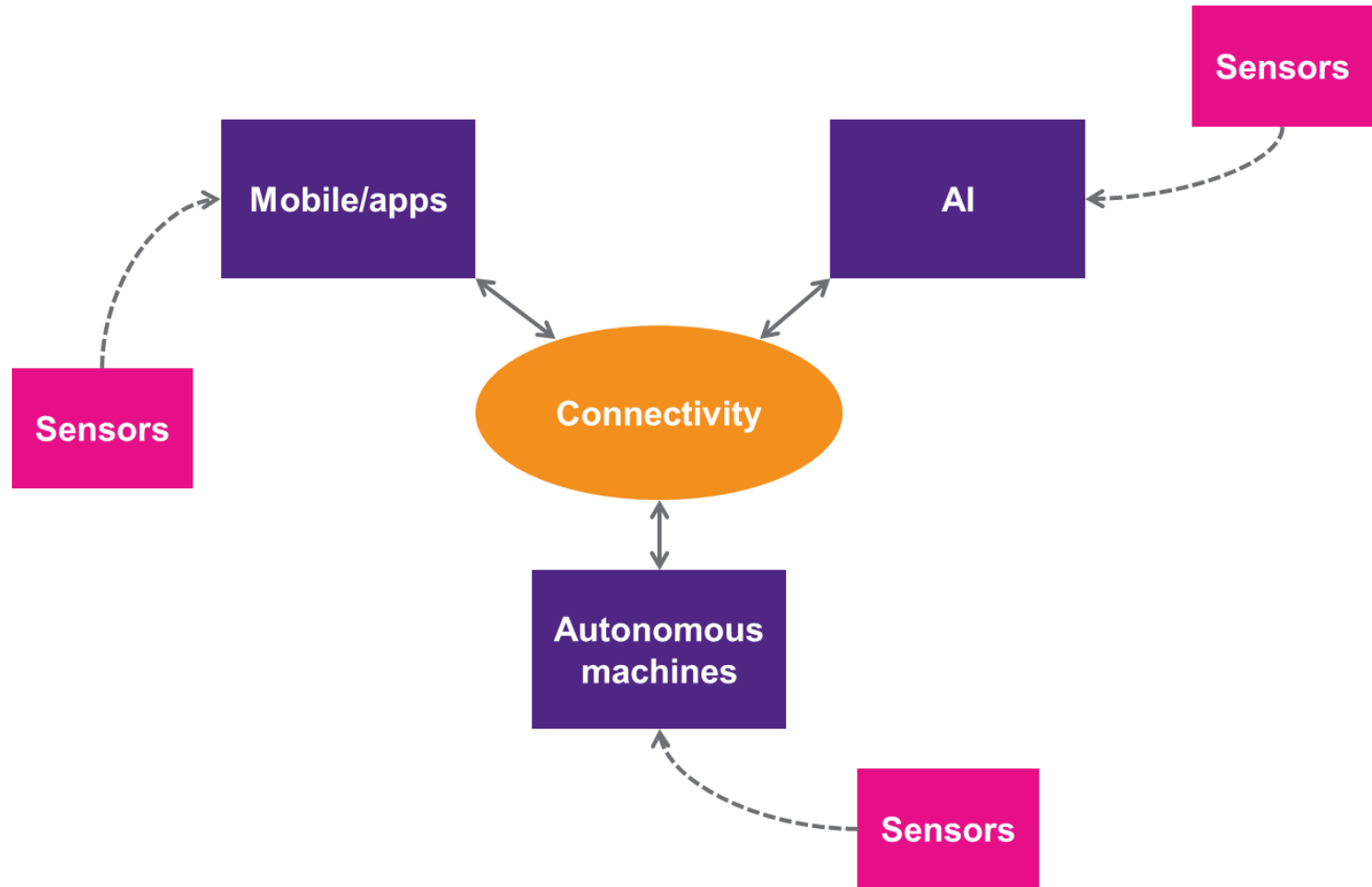
